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## 2. Introduction

The Marion County Emergency Communications District (“Marion County E-911”) is requesting competitive sealed proposals from interested and qualified vendors/dealers for (1) new (2024-2025) Full Size, Crew Cab, 4WD Pickup Truck.

## 3. Response Instructions

Proposals for Chevrolet Silverado 1500 or Ford F150 trucks will be considered. Work Truck models are preferred, however separate proposals on SSV (Chevrolet) and Responder (Ford) models are also encouraged. If a vendor submits proposals for more than one model, each proposal shall be packaged separately.

## 4. Timeline

The RFP will adhere to the following timeline:

Tuesday, September 17<sup>th</sup> 2024: RFP released to Vendors

Tuesday, October 8<sup>th</sup> 2024 @4PM CDT: Deadline for submission

Thursday, October 10<sup>th</sup> 2024 @4PM CDT: Proposals will be reviewed at a called Board of Directors meeting at the Marion County E-911 Office, 650 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave SW, Hamilton, AL 35570

## 5. Legal

Marion County E-911 reserves the right to review bids for up to 10 business days before announcing its decision. Also, Marion County E-911 reserves the right to:

1. Reject any or all bids and request to re-bid;
2. Accept no bids or make no award; and,
3. Request modifications to initial bids

## 6. Vehicle Specifications

1. **Model:** Full-Size 4x4 Pickup. Chevrolet Silverado 1500 or Ford F150
2. **Trim Level:** Work Truck (WT), SSV or Responder
3. **Cab Size:** Crew Cab
4. **Engine:** V6 or V8 with at least 3.5L displacement
5. **Transmission:** Automatic - 4, 8 or 10 speed
6. **Color (in order of preference):** White, Gray, Silver or Navy

7. **Seating:** 40/20/40 or similar Front seats. Full center consoles are not accepted. There should be enough room for a small aftermarket console (Havis 8” or similar) to be mounted in front of the middle seat.
8. **Flooring:** Vinyl flooring is preferred
9. **All other specifications:** Standard for model proposed

## 7. Additional Requirements

1. The vendor shall state an approximate lead time for delivery (or pickup) from the date of purchase
2. Proposals shall be valid for at least 30 days
3. At least (2) Key Fobs shall be included in the proposal
4. If the vendor is located outside of Marion County, AL, a separate line item for delivery shall be quoted. Marion County E-911 will determine whether delivery or pickup is the best option for the agency
5. The vendor shall provide manufacturer warranty information, and any additional warranty options in the proposal. Additional warranties not included as standard shall be quoted as a separate line item

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
